














PdfDoc Numbering User Guide

Toolbar Explanation

	<p>Open an existing document.</p>
	<p>Save a document.</p>
	<p>Select the font and its size for page numbering.</p>
	<p>Set the number colour to RGB colour.</p>
	<p>Set the number colour to CMYK colour.</p>
	<p>Page navigation (Goto the first page, previous page, next page and last page.)</p>
	<p>Show current page of your document.</p>
	<p>Set the margin of the numbering to the edge of the whole document.</p>
	<p>Shows the page size information.</p>
	<p>Alignment function which can be used to adjust: - top-left aligned, top-center aligned, top-right aligned, - middle-left aligned, middle-right aligned, - bottom-left aligned, bottom-center aligned, and bottom-right aligned.</p>
	<p>Set number's position whether to be the same position or flip side position for whole document.</p>
	<p>Start page / End page, prefix, suffix setting for the whole document.</p>

Buttons' function:

- * **Add** to customise the document page number.
- * **Remove** to remove the document page number.
- * **Save** to save the page numbering setting into .txt file.
- * **OK** to confirm the page numbering setting.

- 1) You can set the starting page on any page you wish with different numbering style, such as **normal alphabet style, lower-case roman or upper-case roman**.
- 2) Also, you will be able to type-in your own **prefix** and or **suffix** on each different page.
- 3) If start number cell is empty, then numbering will be blank for that start / end range.
